

House rules

(Persons under 20 years of age may only rent the Seegüetli if adults are present during the entire rental period.

Parking

- No parking in front of the house, whole place (unloading and loading allowed).
- Parking garage is located in front of the barrier (1.00 Fr/hr, 8am-2pm).
- Additional parking (1.00 Fr/hr, 8am-8pm) along Strandbadstrasse (entrance via ferry).

Party room

- · Music allowed until 2.00 am (normal volume).
- The furniture is intended only for the party room.
- · Chairs are to be set up after the event as they were at the start.
- Tables please leave standing.
- · Glass bottles and cardboard must be disposed of yourself.
- · Please do not use thumbtacks for decorations.
- · Tablecloths required.
- The stairwell is not a playground.

Kitchen

- · Do not use the dishwasher.
- · Plates, bowls please pre-wash (glasses do not).
- · Coffee cups and cutlery only in water.
- 2 Nespresso machines (take capsules) and a water dispenser including carafes are available.
- It has heavy current connection (16 & 32 A).

Terrace

- It is not allowed to grill or cook on the terrace.
- Outside socket and extension cord available.

Garden

- · Do not light an open fire on the lawn or gravel area.
- · Charcoal grill & 2 fire bowls (please set up on gravel area only), lanterns, candles available.
- Please bring wood for grill.
- · Please do not use wax torches.
- Put tables and chairs back as they were at the start.
- The burning of fireworks of any kind is prohibited (police regulations).
- By law, music is allowed until 22.00.
- · The legal regulations on peace and order are binding.
- No tents may be set up on the lawn.
- · Tablecloths also required for outside.
- Tablecloths (white) can be rented (180 x 180 cm), 12.00 Fr. per piece.

Key return

- Lock the balcony doors.
- Turn off the light on the terrace.
- Lock the front door and put the key in the key box by the mailbox.
